2. List 3-6 interests or talents Jefferson had.
3. Why was Jefferson chosen to write the Declaration of Independence?
4. What does the Declaration of Independence explain?
5. List 2-3 beliefs about government that Jefferson had.



6. What did Jefferson do for the Library of Congress while he was President?
7. Jefferson's personal book collection, which he sold to Congress, contained books on which subjects and in which languages?
8. Where is the Library of Congress collection housed today? Is this the same place it has always been housed?
9. While serving as the American minister to France in the 1780s, Jefferson developed a taste for what kind of cooking?
10. What was one of the most popular dishes that Jefferson served at his Monticello home? Which dish that he served would you NOT want to try and which would you try?
11. What types of rooms did Jefferson design for his home Monticello and what did they contain?
